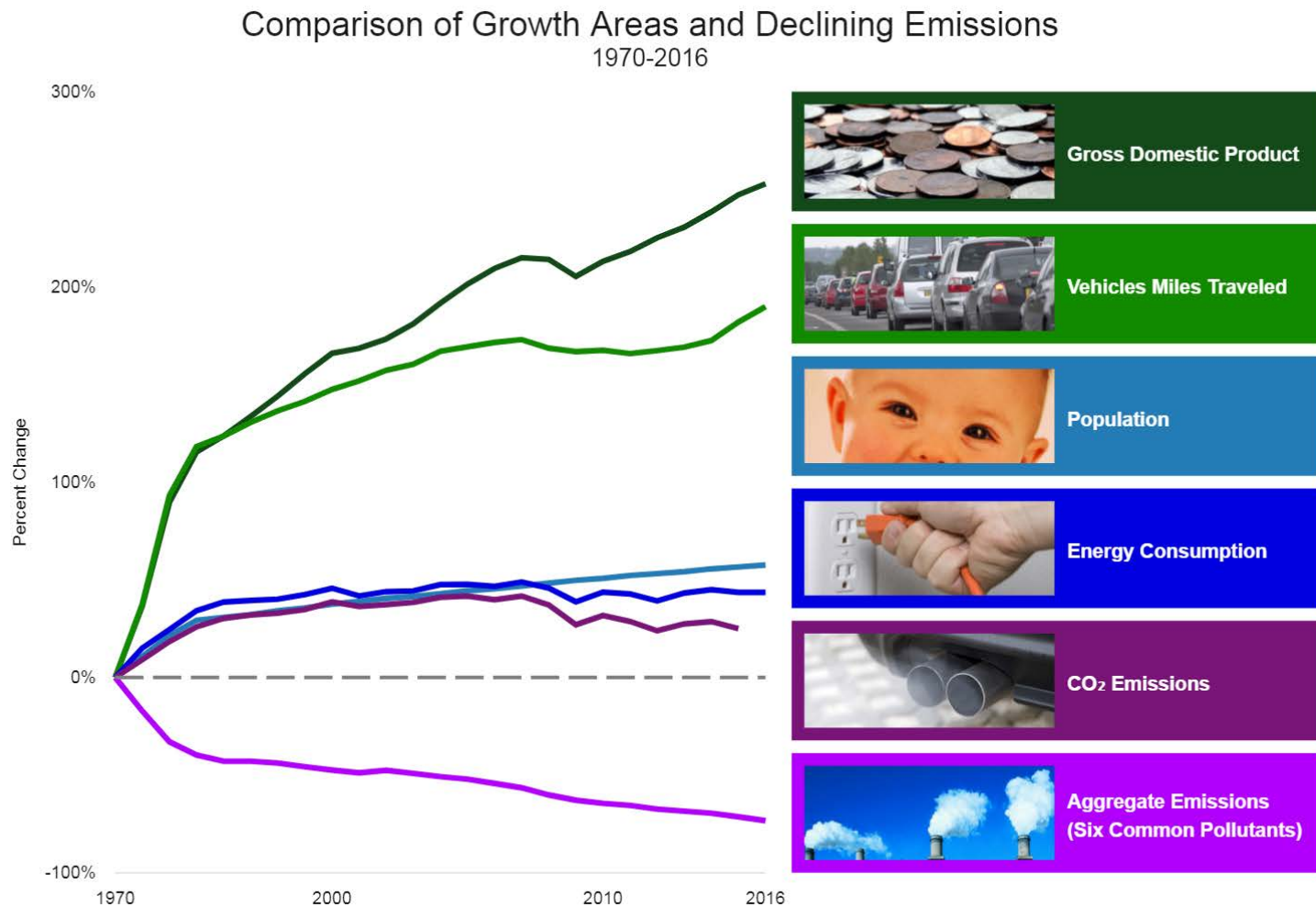

Economic Growth with Cleaner Air

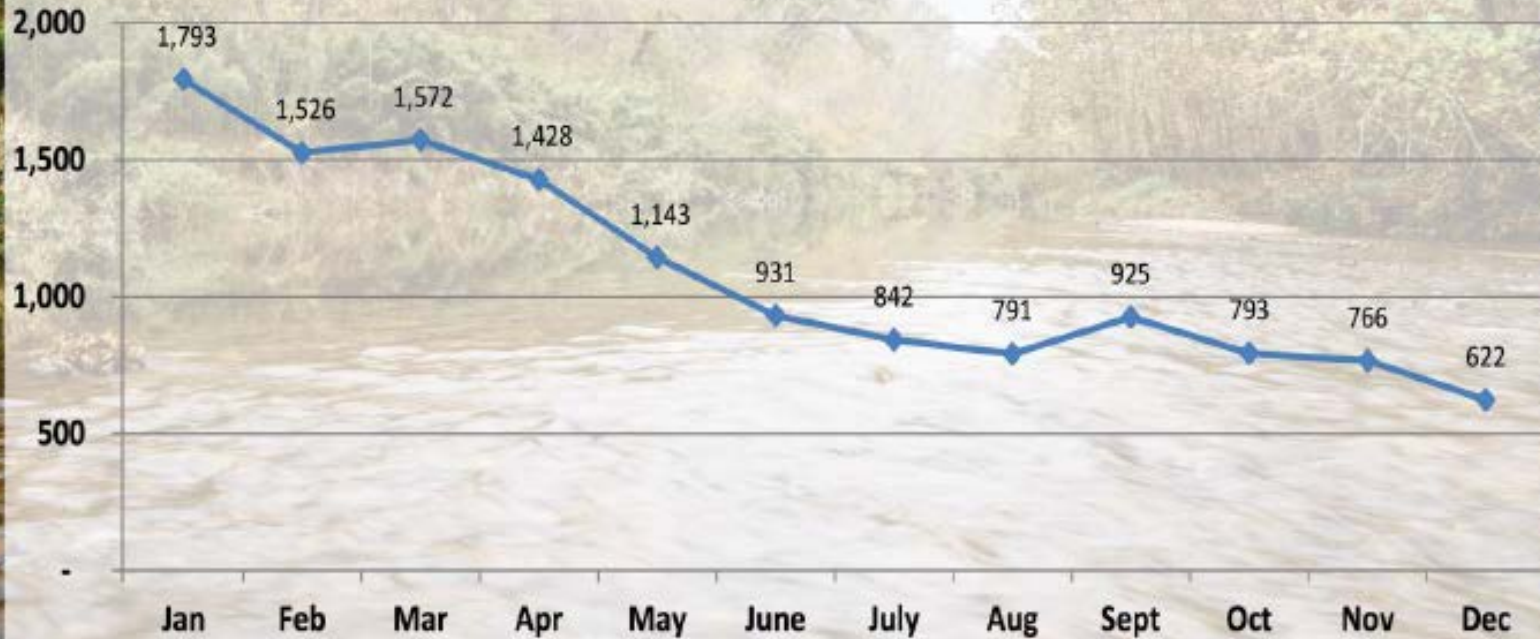
