Executive Order 10

- Signed by Governor Reynolds Jan 10, 2023
 - Review and Replace All Administrative Rules
 - Delete outdated, streamline those that are kept
 - Rule Moratorium until Review Complete
 - Complete Retrospective Analysis for Each Chapter
 - Are the benefits of the rule being achieved?
 - Do the benefits justify the cost?
 - Stakeholder Involvement Required

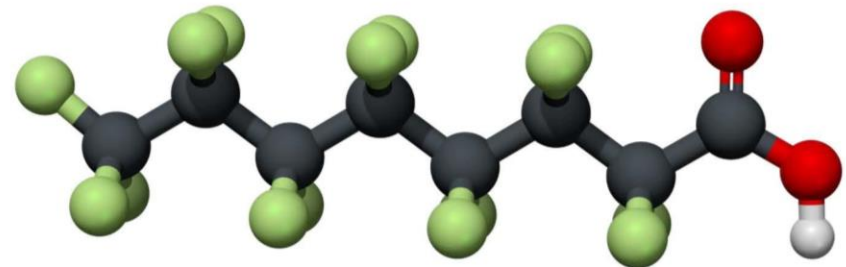

Identify and Minimize Exposure of Iowans to PFAS in Public Drinking Water

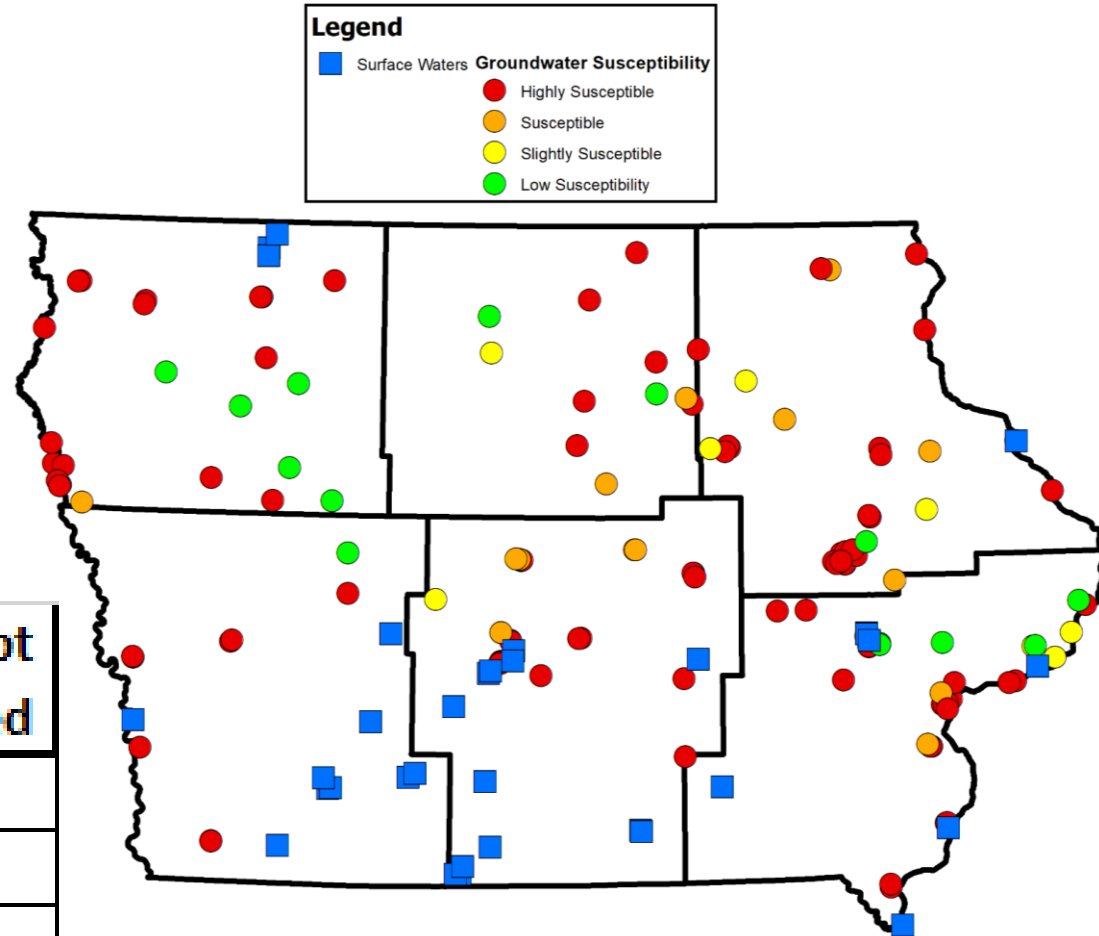
- Developed a surveillance project to evaluate the presence of PFAS in Iowa drinking water
- Used a phased approach prioritizing testing of public drinking water systems
- Developed protocols
- Data driven decisions



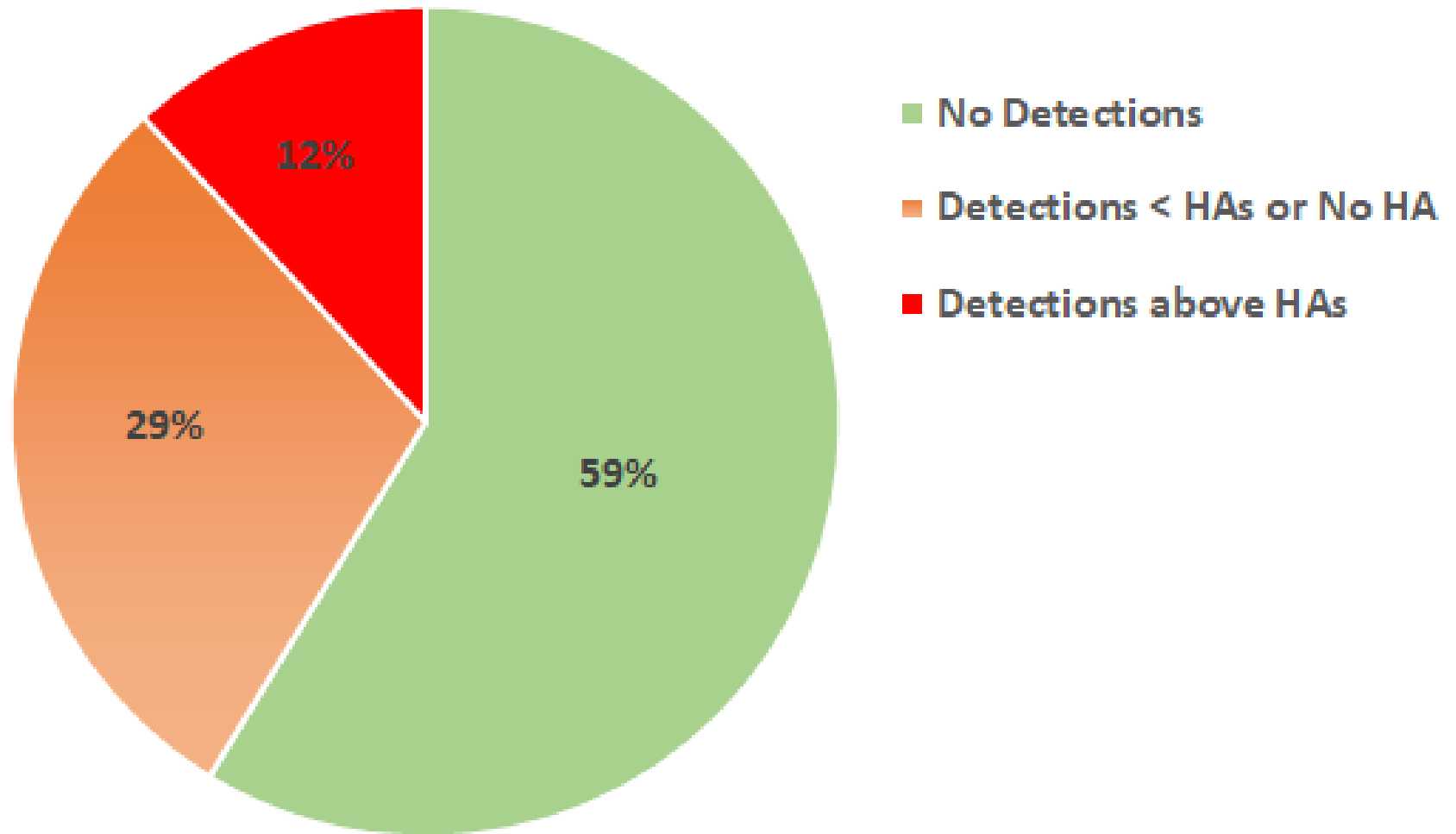
Well Sampling Locations: Tiers 1 – 3

Locations were chosen based on susceptibility to contamination and proximity to potential sources of PFAS.

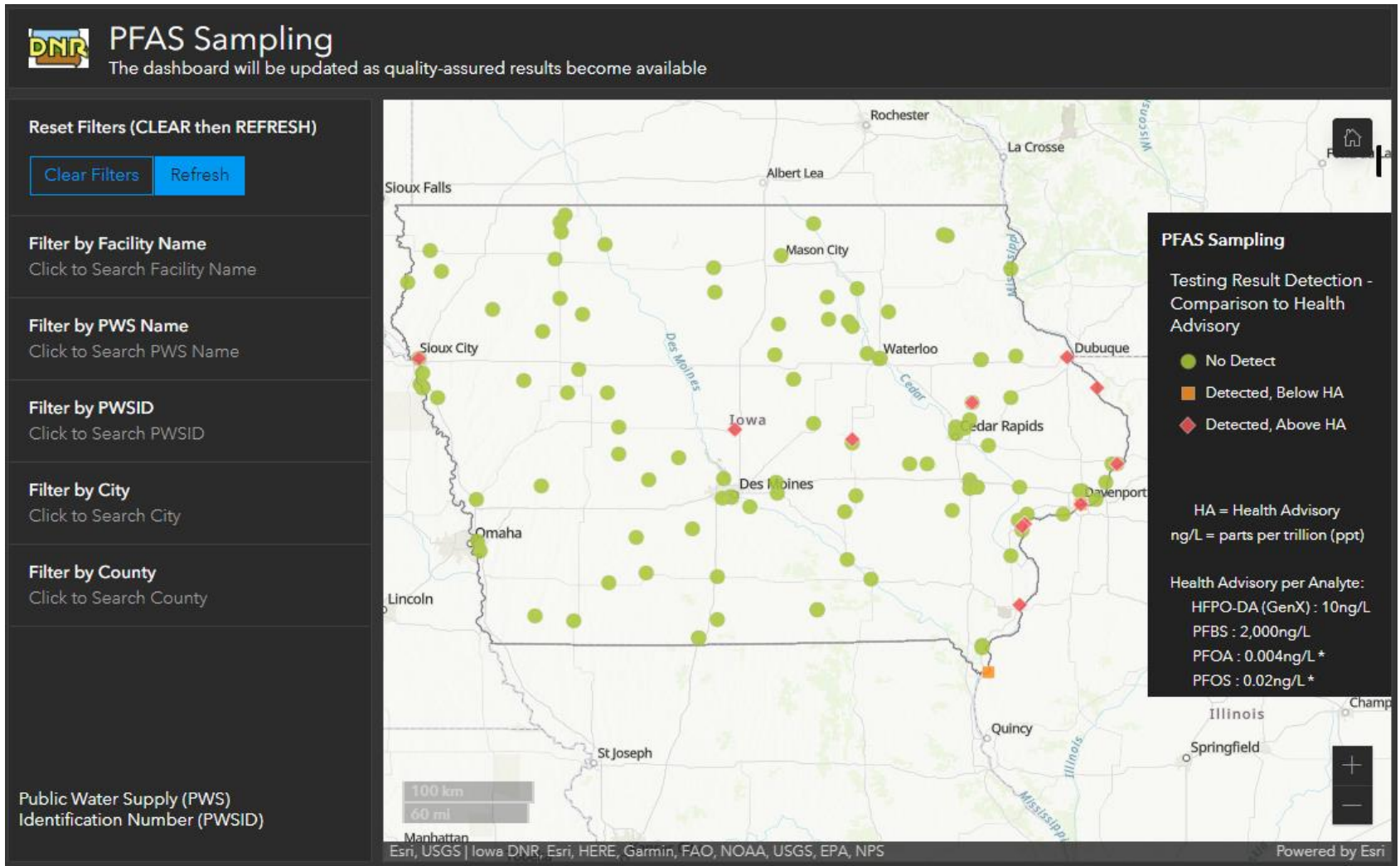
Sampling	PFAS Detected	PFAS Not Detected
Tier 1	70%	30%
Tier 2	31%	69%
Tier 3	20%	80%
